The USF St. Pete 2024 Summer Academy for Investigative Learning (SAIL) is a 6-week program for undergraduates offered twice a week for two hours beginning the week of May 27th. The sessions are Monday/Wednesday from 1 PM - 3 PM and will be hybrid (with some required in person). If selected, you will be expected to attend all 10 meetings as well as the Final Event on 7/24/24.

SAIL is being developed to introduce undergraduate participants to the profound significance of research in our ever-evolving society, challenge them to confront local and global issues, and empower them to actively engage in research endeavors at USF and beyond.
