Dr. Sommer is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Sociology at the University of South Florida. Her research uses mixedmethods to examine how institutional factors impact global inequality in environment and development outcomes. Currently, Jamie is interested in what rights states afford citizens in terms of their rights to natural resources and access to environmental information, participation, and decision-making. In doing so, she asks why, where, and what are the consequences of environmental citizenship. She is particularly excited about her work with the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Gender Division in evaluating climate change mitigation and adaptation projects at the local level in developing countries.
