Cheryl Hall is Associate Professor and Associate Director in the School of Interdisciplinary Global Studies at the University of South Florida. She is a political theorist with specialties in environmental political theory, feminist theory, and emotion in politics. Her research focuses on thinking through the roles that human capacities and practices might play in encouraging or discouraging more just and sustainable ways of life, especially in the face of climate change and massive biodiversity loss. She is currently working on the question of how to encourage political action on climate change by cultivating the emotional resources necessary to sustain consistent cultural attention to the issue.
