iCAR representatives along with the iCAR research team and volunteers lead by Ms. Rachelle Pontes participated in Child's Park Family Fun Day meeting as part of iCAR's on-going outreach/engagement efforts called 'Child's Park Community Resiliency Project'

The iCAR team accomplished the following:

- 1. Followed up from our past meeting in Fall 2017 right after Irma
 - a. Feedback re: are you ready for hurricane season 2018?
 - b. What has been done since Irma?
 - c. What needs to be done?
- 2. Based on conversations at the May 15th, 2018 Child's Park Neighborhood meeting, iCAR helped Child's Park with their June 9th Child's Park Family Fun Day by reaching out to City and County Emergency Management offices, and Red Cross representatives to host information tables.
- 3. Regarding iCAR research project 'Coastal flooding: An integrative analysis of socioeconomic vulnerability and its relationship to successful coastal adaptation and resilience' (where Child's Park is one of our study neighborhoods):
 - a. We distributed and collected surveys to assess community perspectives; handed out electronic link for survey at the event
 - b. We set up sign up for Interviews received commitment from people for interviews.
